DID YOU KNOW?

The waters around Mull and Iona are rich with marine life, one of which is the Basking Shark, the second largest fish in the world and which is mostly seen from June to September following plankton blooms. Minke whale appear during the months of April & May, and stay long into the autumn months, when the seas are at their warmest. Common dolphins are seen from the boats in larger pods feeding and passing through hebridean waters, whereas bottlenose dolphins are seen from land and seen playing and feeding in local waters.
